

Success for Carnegie Development Swimmers

12 young Carnegie swimmers from the Development Squad competed in the East Lothian Novice Meet held at Mercat Gait (Prestonpans) on Saturday 2nd May. With ages ranging from 7-12yrs, the youngster put in some remarkable performances.

In the morning session, 9yr old Aiden Mitchell picked up Gold in the Boys 25m Butterfly with a time of (00:24.21), a Silver in the 50m Backstroke with a time of (00:49.62) and the icing on the cake, a speeding ticket and a 'Swam too Fast' award in the 50m Freestyle in a time of (00:42.48). Team-mate 9yr old Claire Lee picked up Silver in the Girls 50m Backstroke with a time of (00:49.50)

Medal success continued in the afternoon with 10yr old Sol Sweeney picking up Gold in the 50m Backstroke (00:46.10) and a Bronze in the 50m Breaststroke (00:54.10). His older sister, Savannah picked up a speeding ticket and a 'Swam too Fast' award in the Girls 11yrs 50m Freestyle (00:37.85). In the Girls 10yrs 50m Freestyle, Holly Sim also picked up a speeding ticket and a 'Swam too Fast' award with a time of (00:40.94). 10yr old Grant Ogilvie picked up a Silver medal in the Boys 10yrs 50m Breaststroke with a time of (00:53.20).

Other swimmers who competed but missed out on medals but set new lifetime personal bests were 7yr old Lucy Ross & Levi Sweeney, 8yr old Gavin Ogilvie, 10yr old Emily Adams and 11yr old Taylor Fox and Jordan Dingwall.
