

## **Carnegie SC Excel at Portobello Mad March Meet**

29 Carnegie swimmers competed in the Portobello Mad March Meet held at Mercat Gait Centre (Prestonpans) on Sat 21<sup>st</sup> and Sun 22<sup>nd</sup> March and what a performance from the talented youngsters.

On Saturday, 9yr old Fraser Beeby picked up the Top Boy award with Gold medals in the 100m IM, 50m Breaststroke, 50m Butterfly & 50m Backstroke plus Silver in the 50m Freestyle. Hamish Neil competing in the same age group and returning from illness picked up 6<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Freestyle, 50m Breaststroke & 5<sup>th</sup> place in the 100m IM. Team mate Aiden Mitchell and Andrew Waterworth picked up 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> place respectively in the 50m Backstroke.

9yr old Sophie Ross picked up Gold in the 50m Butterfly, Silver in the 50m Freestyle, Bronze in the 50m Breaststroke and 4<sup>th</sup> place finishes in the 100m IM and 50m Backstroke. Competing in the same age group, Megan McGhee picked up Silver in the 100m IM, Bronze in the 50m Freestyle and 5<sup>th</sup> place finishes in the 50m Breaststroke and 50m Backstroke. Claire Lee picked up a 5<sup>th</sup> place finish in the 100m IM and a 6<sup>th</sup> place finish in the 50m Freestyle. Tabitha Hill picked up a 6<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Breaststroke.

In the Boys 10yrs category, Michael Watson picked up Gold in the 50m Breaststroke, Bronze in the 50m Backstroke, 4<sup>th</sup> place in the 200m IM and 6<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Butterfly. Team mate Andrew England picked up 4<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Backstroke, 200m Freestyle and 6<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Freestyle. Competing in the same age group Jordan McKilligan picked up a 4<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Breaststroke and 5<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Freestyle.

In the Girls 10yrs category, Sally Christie picked up Gold in the 50m Breaststroke, Silver in the 200m IM, 4<sup>th</sup> place in the 200m Freestyle and 6<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Butterfly. Lucy Bedborough picked up Silver in the 200m Freestyle, 4<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Freestyle, 5<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Breaststroke and 6<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Backstroke. Brooke Gillies picked up 6<sup>th</sup> place in the 200m Freestyle.

In the Boys 11yrs category, Robbie Carmichael picked up Silver in the 50m Butterfly, Bronze in the 200m IM and a 5<sup>th</sup> place in the 50m Freestyle.

In the Girls 11yrs category Megan Hill picked up a 5<sup>th</sup> place finish in the 50m Freestyle and 6<sup>th</sup> place finishes in the 50m Backstroke, 200m Freestyle and 200m IM.

In the Boys 8yrs category, Gavin Ogilvie picked up 6<sup>th</sup> place awards in the 25m Breaststroke and 25m Backstroke.

The youngster did even better in the team events picking up Gold medals in the Boys and Girls 8-9yrs 200m Freestyle and Medley relays, Bronze in the Girls 10-11yrs 200m Medley Relay and Boys 10-11yrs 200m Freestyle Relay. Carnegie 'B' Boys 10-11yrs Team and Carnegie 'A' Girls 10-11yrs picked up 5<sup>th</sup> place in the 200m Freestyle Relay.

Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> saw Silver medals for Andrew England and Euan McElwee in the 200m Backstroke, Bronze medals for Eleanor England and Craig Bowman in the 200m Backstroke and 400m Freestyle respectively and a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish for Euan McElwee in the 200m Freestyle.
