

InCAS Distance Meet Report

Carnegie's youngsters continue to impress with some remarkable swims at the InCAS Distance Meet held at Kirkcaldy Swimming Pool over the weekend of 1st / 2nd May. With a number of swimmers still chasing DRP Bronze squad times, this was their chase to put in a performance and performance they did.

In **Session 1**, 10yr old Fraser Beeby picked up Gold in the Boys 10/under 200m Butterfly and team mate James Collyer Silver. New comer to Carnegie SC, 11 yr old Craig Mclean picked up a 5th place medal in the Boys 11/12yrs 200m Butterfly.

In the 800m Freestyle, 10yr old Megan McGhee picked up Bronze in the 10/under age group, Caitlin Burns Silver in the 13/14yrs age group and Eleanor England a 6th place medal.

In the Boys 200m Breaststroke, Fraser Beeby picked up Silver in the 10/under age group, Fraser Reid 5th and Andrew England 6th in the 11/12yrs age group.

In the Girls 200m IM, Sophie Ross picked up a 4th place medal in the 10/under age group and Caitlin Burns Silver in the 13/14 age group.

In **Session 2**, Fraser Beeby picked up Gold in the Boys 10/under 1500m Freestyle, Fraser Reid Gold and Craig McLean 6th in the 11/12yrs age group and Euan McElwee 4th in the 13/14yrs age group.

In the Girls 200m Breaststroke, Megan McGhee picked up a 5th place medal in the 10/unders and Hannah Gray 4th place in the 13/14yrs age group.

In the Boys 200m IM, Fraser picked up Gold in the 10/under age group, team mates James Collyer Bronze and Hamish Neil 6th.

In **Session 3**, 10yr old Claire Lee picked up Silver in the 200m Backstroke, team mates Sophie Ross Silver and Megan McGhee 6th. Caitlin Burns picked up a 5th place in the 13/14yrs age group.

It was a 1-2-3 in the Boys 10/under 200m Freestyle with Fraser Beeby Gold, James Collyer Silver and Hamish Neil Bronze. It was also Gold for Fraser Reid in the 11/12yrs age group with younger brother Greig picking up 6th place.

In the Girls 400m Freestyle, Claire Lee picked up 6th place in the 10/under group and Caitlin Burns Bronze in the 13/14yrs age group.

In the Boys 400m IM, it was Gold for Fraser Beeby and Silver for James Collyer in the 10/under age group. Craig McLean picked up 4th place in the 11/12yrs age group.

In **Session 4**, Megan McGhee picked up Silver in the Girls 10/under 200m Freestyle whilst team mate Sophie Ross picked up Bronze and Claire Lee 4th.

In the Boys 200m Backstroke, Fraser Beeby picked up Gold in the 10/under age group, James Collyer Bronze and Aidan Mitchell 5th place. In the 11/12yrs age group, Fraser Reid picked up Silver and Euan McElwee Bronze in the 13/14yrs age group.

In the final event of the weekend, the Boys 400m Freestyle, it was 1-2-3-6 in the 10/under age group with Fraser Beeby picking up Gold, James Collyer Silver, Hamish Neil Bronze and Aidan Mitchell 6th. Fraser Reid picked up Gold and Craig McLean 5th place in the 11/12yrs age group and Euan McElwee 5th in the 13/14yrs age group.

Not surprising, Fraser Beeby picked up Top Boy in the 10/under category with 7 Gold and 1 Silver.

Overall Top Club went to West Lothian (Composite Club) with Carnegie SC finishing in 2nd place, Warrender Bath 3rd, InCAS 4th, Heart of Midlothian 5th and Fins ASC 6th.
